A Best Friend

5 year-old Gabby was removed from an unsafe, abusive home. She arrived at Wayfinder's temporary shelter care program during the holidays with only the clothes she was wearing. Our caring staff noticed a popular cartoon character on her shirt and asked Gabby about it. Gabby's eyes lit up and said the character was her best friend and that she would sometimes talk to him when she was scared. Two days later, Gabby woke up to find a gift box near her bed. Inside was her best friend in stuffed animal form! That same day, she also learned that staff had located a close relative who had been hoping to care for her.

JOY

Baby George was diagnosed with vision impairment and has many other medical issues. He is immunocompromised and his family is extremely cautious about taking him to events. Since he could not attend Wayfinder's last holiday event, George's Wayfinder specialist brought the holidays to his family: she brought them a special holiday meal, decorations, crafts and gifts for George and his siblings. George's parents shared a family photo with their specialist later that evening with just one word: JOY.
